

# T-PORTS - ON FARM STORAGE PROGRAM 2023/24

At T-Ports, we understand the pressure of harvest logistics and are pleased to support growers with our On Farm Storage (OFS) Program for the 23/24 harvest with a \$10 per tonne payment direct to growers from T-Ports.

The OFS Program is purely focused on providing growers with an incentive to use or build OFS infrastructure to capture better control of their product and revenue. We can create efficiencies by directing grain delivered from OFS direct to our port bins at Lucky Bay and Wallaroo in readiness for immediate shipping. Such efficiencies drive cost savings that will be passed onto participating growers.

## **The OFS Process:**



Register your initial details NOW, including your estimated tonnes by 30 Nov, storage types and transport arrangements The T-Ports operations team will be in contact before and during harvest The T-Ports operations team will contact all participants with quality and tonnage data and arrange samples for collection or delivery (in line with T-Ports guidelines.) The T-Ports operations team will be in contact to discuss optimal delivery windows between 1st JAN – 15th FEB and stored grades that suit growers and export arrangements. The program allows growers to forward contract to grain traders or upon delivery, warehouse and sell at your convenience. Growers will receive \$10 per tonne during April directly from T-Ports.

If Growers have fixed, permanent fumigatable silos- Please call Tim to discuss further options and increased revenue.





#### 1) Register your information:

In order for us to plan effectively in line with our shipping program, we will need to know:

#### Approx how many tonnes and what commodity (BA,WH) you plan on storing on farm for late delivery to T-Ports.

•Type of storage you will be using (bags, sheds, stacks or fumigatable silo's) •Transport arrangements (will you be carting your own grain, using a carrier, how many loads you will be able to deliver each day?)

## 2) Reviewing participating growers information:

In consideration with our shipping program and export requirements, T-Ports operations team will review information provided. Only certain types of OFS infrastructure and appropriate practices can be included within the OFS program. Acceptable OFS types include sheds, stacks, silo bags, and fumigatable silo's. This is to provide incentives for grower expenditure into more suitable OFS to facilitate better practices and longer-term OFS with future program expansion.



## 3) Providing samples as per T-Ports guidelines and in line with GTA standards:

Taking a representative sample is an important step in the process. When you are filling your on farm storage, a sample should be collected as per T-Ports guidelines and in line with GTA standards.

·As per GTA standards, 15kg running sample per 250 tonnes is required

·Participants can collect sample bags from any T-Ports delivery site or arrange via Tim Gurney.

•15kg per 250t is equal to a 1.5kg sample for every 25t loaded into the partition/OFS. For best results please take these samples within the middle of each filling process (e.g. not at the very start or end of each chaser bin load whilst filling)

•Each sample should be bagged, sealed and an the Ex Farm Treatment Declaration form (attached and available on our website) should accompany each partition of storage(each silo bag,shed,bin).

•You can deliver the final sample to any T-Ports delivery site or contact Tim Gurney who will make arrangements for collection. •T Ports operations team will be in contact with the indicative sample results. It is important to note that each truck will still be subject to the normal delivery process and will be sampled and graded accordingly upon receival.

## 4) Upon delivery:


Our Operations team will be in touch to co-ordinate a delivery window for each parcel of grain. We will be considering the indicative quality of the grain, the tonnes you have in storage, speed of intake and tonnes required for immediate shipping. It is important to align these factors with our shipping program to create an efficient and convenient process. We will be in touch during November and December to gather any additional data to assist with the process.T Ports Active Binning is available during this program on a per port bin/export requirement basis.We will also work with you when determining the best delivery window to ensure you are provided with sufficient notice to assist with planning of un-loading equipment. It is our intention to have all grain stored as part of the OFS program delivered to Port by mid-February.

#### 5) Payment on completion of the program:

T-Ports will pay participating growers \$10 per tonne on completion of the program. We anticipate this payment will be made during April.

• Grain can be forward contracted into this program via our grain trade partners or simply delivered, warehoused, and sold at your convenience.

The information in this updated flyer (as at Oct 2023) supersedes any other previous information supplied by T-Ports with regards to the T-Ports OFS Program for season 23/24.
